(Please see our website for details.) Today, thanks to many of you, we are closing out 2021 with this sold-out event and a celebration of our scholarship recipients, Ethan, and Antonio.

As we enter 2022, we are looking forward to activities that will help us to "Keep Jazz Alive", promote the careers of upcoming Jazz musicians via scholarships, and allow for us to gather, enjoy, and celebrate JAZZ. The Birth of the Wayne Barlow Scholarship Award

The Jacksonville Jazz Society, Inc was co-founded by Wayne Barlow of Brooklyn, NY and Na'im Rashid of Philadelphia, PA. When the two men met in Jacksonville, FL, in 2007 they quickly discovered that they shared the same passion for Jazz and wanted to preserve this music genre in the city of Jacksonville, FL.

In 2009, the two men had a vision of creating a jazz organization comprised of professional and non-professional musicians with people who also loved Jazz. Their shared vision brought the Jacksonville Jazz Society to life. Its mission, "Keeping Jazz Alive" in Jacksonville, FL.

In 2011, as a means of continuing the preservation of Jazz in Jacksonville, Na'im decided to help young aspiring jazz musicians to further their musical careers. This led to the First Annual Scholarship Fundraiser which was established in 2012. Wayne Barlow died on January 29, 2016. In 2017, Na'im renamed the Annual Scholarship to the Wayne Barlow Scholarship to honor his best friend and keep the spirit of the dream they conceived in 2009.

A SPECIAL THANK YOU TO OUR FEATURED ARTIST

The Jacksonville Jazz Society thanks you for your support in making our 9th Annual Wayne Barlow Scholarship Fundraiser a success.

Grammy-nominated, Jacksonville-based keyboardist and composer Elisha Atlas Parris started playing keyboard when he was 12 years old. From a musical and spiritual family, his musicianship was strongly influenced by both his parents. His father, pastor of a Pentecostal church, played trombone, and his mother a piano teacher and church musician. Elisha's first "gig" was playing the Hammond C3 organ, piano, and synthesizer at his father's church. It was in that unique spiritual and improvisational environment that Elisha developed his distinctive style of keyboard performance. Elisha received his formal training from the Dean's Music Conservatory and Edward Waters College. Since then, he has released three instrumental albums, two gospel albums, in addition to appearing on over 30 albums as a keyboardist, writer, or producer.

Over the past 30 years, Elisha has been afforded the opportunity to play as a bandleader or sideman for jazz festivals and clubs across the country. Elisha has performed at the Jacksonville Jazz Festival, the "second-largest jazz festival in the nation according to Superpages, Jax Beach Jazz Series, Sun Fest, Golden Isles Summer Music Series, Sundown Music Series, The House of Blues and The Historic B Sharp Jazz Cafe. He also serves as Music Director for several plays, recording projects, and artists including the Stellar Award-winning inspirational jazz duo, Allen & Allen.

This summer, Elisha released his 4th instrumental album as a leader. The first new project in 7 years, called "The Story of a Preacher's Kid" on PEInc Records. He's currently working on a volume of 70's covers and a collection of sacred hymns.

Ethan Halligan



Ethan Halligan, trombonist, is a graduate of Douglas Anderson School of the Arts and a freshman at the University of North Florida (UNF). Although he is young in years, his musical accomplishments are many!

Ethan's first arrangement was performed live at the Friday Musical at the John Lumpkin Institute. He also played one of his arrangements, "If I Only Had a Brain" from The Wizard of Oz, with his Jazz band in a school concert. Continuing to display his many talents, Ethan traveled to the Midwest Clinic in Chicago where he performed a featured ballad, "Ever After" by Dave Springfield. At UNF, Ethan deservedly received accolades from Dave Steinmeyer, one of the music world's most sought-after jazz trombonists, after performing as a featured trombone.

Ethan's performances include:

- John Lumpkin Institute (intermittent participation throughout high school)
- Jacksonville Youth Symphony Orchestra, 2018

It is not surprising that his amazing musical talents have garnered him numerous awards and recognitions which began very early in his musical performances which include:

- Louis Armstrong Award, May 2017
- Florida All-State Concert Band, euphonium, 9th grade
- Outstanding Soloist, Jacksonville Univ. Jazz Festival April 2019
- Florida All-State Concert Band, euphonium, 10th grade
- Florida All-State Symphonic Band, euphonium, 12th grade
- Nassau/Duval District Honor Bands, 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018

Ethan has performed numerous solos and ensembles. Of note are Sonata in G Minor by Allen Ostrander (Trombone) played on Euphonium, 9th grade; Andate et Allegro by Ropartz (Trombone or baritone) played on Euphonium; 10th grade; Arpeggione by Franz Schubert Arr. David Warden (Euphonium), 11th grade and "Down in the River" Tuba Euphonium Sextet Arr. David Gluck, 11th grade. In October of this year, Ethan displayed his musical talents on the Greens of Eagle Landing where he played his trombone at a Jacksonville Jazz Society listening event.

Ethan is well positioned for an exciting and extremely promising career in the music world as is evidenced by his demonstrated skills. For these reasons, the Jacksonville Jazz Society is proud to recognize Ethan as one of our 2021 Scholarship recipients.

Antonio Vergara is a junior at the University of North Florida (UNF) with a Double Major in Jazz Studies and Flute Performance. To date, Antonio has been awarded numerous awards and accolades with a promising future in Jazz music. He is a Jazz Saxophonist and Flutist but his music talents go beyond these instruments. He is proficient in Soprano, Alto, Tenor, and Baritone Saxophones, Flute, Bb Clarinet, and Bass Clarinet. He also teaches Saxophone, Flute, Clarinet, Music Theory, Improvisation/Harmony, and "beginning" Piano.

Antonio honed his skills through his participation in his Middle School and High School bands from 2011 to 2019. His other musical endeavors included:

- University of North Florida Music Summer Camp - 2015, 2016, 2017
- Florida Symphony Youth Orchestras - Jazz Orchestra One, Lead Alto - 2018-2019
- FMEA All-State Jazz Band, 1st Alto Saxophone - 2019
- UNF Wind Symphony, 2nd Flute - 2019
- UNF Jazz Ensemble 1, Baritone Sax, Alto 1 performing throughout Florida and Georgia - 2019-20, 2021-22
- Playing Baritone Saxophone with the LPT Salsa Band - 2021
- UNF Orchestra, 2nd Flute and Piccolo - 2021-22

Antonio's musical education has likewise been remarkable, and he has proven himself to be a dedicated student of the Jazz music genre. He has received instruction from:

- Studied Saxophone with Daniel Ferri, Adjunct Professor at Stetson University - 2015-2016
- Studied Saxophone with Jeff Rupert, Director of Jazz Studies at University of Central Florida - 2018-2019
- Studying Classical Flute with Rhonda Cassano, Adjunct Professor at University of North Florida, and Flutist in the Jacksonville Symphony Orchestra - 2020-2021
- Studying Classical Clarinet with Patrick Graham, Adjunct Professor at University of North Florida, and Clarinetist in the Jacksonville Symphony Orchestra - 2020-2021

In October of this year, Antonio displayed his musical talents on the Greens of Eagle Landing where he played his saxophone for 200 plus JJS guests. As the beat goes on and we move into 2022, Antonio will kick off the new year by traveling to Virginia to perform with the Navy Commodores, the premier Navy Jazz Band, and Melissa Aldana, a Grammy nominated saxophonist. This honor comes as a result of Antonio winning the 2022 Navy Band International Saxophone Symposium Jazz Competition. The Jacksonville Jazz Society is proud to recognize Antonio as one of our 2021 Scholarship recipients.
